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STOCK MARKET REPORT

Week Ended January 10, 2020



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DERIVATIVES

The Derivative Market closed the week with a total of 13 contracts worth Kes.474,000 transacted. The Equity contract expiring in 19th March 2020 had 3 contracts valued at Kes.164,000 transacted.

EQUITIES

The Bourse closed the week with 70M shares valued at Kes.2.66Bn against 26M shares valued at Kes.905M transacted the previous week.

Turnover for Friday stood at Kes.836M from the previous session's Kes.664M, the number of shares traded stood at 20M against 16M posted the previous session.

INDICES

All NSE indices registered positive gains during the week as follows;

The NSE 20 share index was down 6.86 points to stand at 2701.04.

All Share Index (NASI) ended the week 3.99 points higher to settle at 171.36.

The NSE 25 Share index gained 70.99 points or 1.72% to stand at 4207.90.

Banking Sector

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.1.7Bn transacted which accounted for 64.68% of the week's traded value. Equity Group Holdings was the week's main feature with 17.9M shares valued at Kes.972M changing hands at between Kes.53.00 and Kes.55.25. KCB Group moved 6.7M shares worth Kes.364.8M at a fairly stable price of Kes.55.00. Diamond Trust Bank climbed 9.32% to Kes.120.25 moving 1.4M shares worth Kes.170M.

Insurance Sector

The Insurance Sector had shares worth Kes.28M transacted which accounted for 1.06% of the week's traded value. Britam Holdings recorded a 1.06% gain to close the week at Kes.9.52 with shares worth Kes.16M transacted.

Manufacturing & Allied Sector

The Manufacturing & Allied Sector had shares worth Kes.163.5M transacted which represented 6.13% of the week's traded value. E.A Breweries closed the week 3.80% higher to Kes.205.00 moving 745,000 shares valued at Kes.152M.

Telecommunication Sector


