Banking

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.171M transacted which accounted for 28.43% of the day's traded value. Equity Group Holdings actively moved 2.25M shares valued at Kes.78.9M at between Kes.34.90 and Kes.35.60. KCB Group moved 1.6M shares worth Kes.56.9M at a fairly stable price of Kes.35.35. ABSA Bank Kenya moved 2.2M shares worth Kes.24M and closed at Kes.10.80.

Energy & Petroleum

The Energy & Petroleum sector had shares worth 6.6M traded & accounted for 1.10% of the day's traded value. Kenya Power & Lighting moved 3.5M shares worth Kes.6.2M and closed at Kes.1.74.

Insurance

The Insurance sector had shares worth 8.8M traded & accounted for 1.47% of the day's traded value. Jubilee Holdings moved 25,000 shares worth Kes.6.4M at between Kes.251.00 and Kes.255.00.

Manufacturing & Allied

The Manufacturing & Allied sector had shares worth 31M traded & accounted for 5.16% of the day's traded value. E.A Breweries rose by 1.08% to Kes.163.75, up from Kes.162.00 registered the previous session with shares worth Kes.30.8M transacted.

Telecommunication

Safaricom was the day's main feature with 13M shares valued at Kes.382M changing hands at between Kes.28.20 and Kes.29.00; this represented 63.32% of the day's traded value.
