### EQUITIES

The bourse opened the week with a total of 11.8M shares valued at Kes.337M, against 37M shares valued at Kes.1.6Bn posted on Friday.

#### **Banking**

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.253M transacted which accounted for 75.16% of the day's traded value. Equity Group Holdings was the day's main feature with 5.8M shares valued at Kes.209M changing hands at between Kes.34.10 and Kes.36.10. KCB Group up 1.12% to Kes.36.05 moved 359,000 shares valued at Kes.12.9M. Co-operative Bank moved 810,000 shares worth Kes.10M and closed at Kes.12.95.

#### **Commercial & Services**

The Commercial & Services sector had shares worth 2M traded & accounted for 0.59% of the day's traded value. Kenya Airways closed the day 8.46% higher to Kes.2.18 moving 638,000 shares valued at Kes.1.3M.

#### **Energy & Petroleum**

The Energy & Petroleum sector had shares worth 1.4M traded & accounted for 0.43% of the day's traded value. Kenya Power & Lighting moved 611,000 shares worth Kes.1.1M and closed at Kes.1.96.

#### **Manufacturing & Allied**

The Manufacturing & Allied sector had shares worth 18.8M traded & accounted for 5.58% of the day's traded value. E.A Breweries moved 113,000 shares worth Kes.18.6M at a fairly stable price of Kes.165.00.

#### **Telecommunication**

Safaricom moved 2M shares valued at Kes.59M at between Kes.27.85 and Kes.29.00; this represented 17.56% of the day's traded value.
