Banking

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.309M transacted which accounted for 52.29% of the day's traded value. KCB Group actively moved 4.3M shares valued at Kes.154M at between Kes.34.00 and Kes.36.40. Equity Group Holdings down 5.39% to Kes.34.20 moved 3.6M shares valued at Kes.124M. Stanbic Holdings moved 178,000 shares worth Kes.15M and closed at Kes.85.50.

Commercial & Services

The Commercial & Services sector had shares worth 2.1M traded & accounted for 0.36% of the day's traded value. Kenya Airways extended the previous session's gains by 9.84% to Kes.3.46 with shares worth Kes.1.4M transacted.

Energy & Petroleum

The Energy & Petroleum sector had shares worth 2.1M traded & accounted for 0.36% of the day's traded value. Kenya Power & Lighting moved 854,000 shares worth Kes.1.6M and closed at Kes.1.87.

Manufacturing & Allied

The Manufacturing & Allied sector had shares worth 76M traded & accounted for 12.92% of the day's traded value. E.A Breweries rose by 1.23% to Kes.164.75, up from Kes.162.75 registered the previous session with shares worth Kes.76M transacted.

Telecommunication

Safaricom was the day's biggest mover with 6.7M shares valued at Kes.194M at between Kes.28.90 and Kes.29.35; this represented 32.81% of the day's traded value.

New Gold ETF moved 2,000 units valued at Kes.4M and closed at Kes.1760.00.
